This fee covers the game suit, game day shirt, weightlifting clothes, two team meals, tournament fees, equipment (everything you see on the pool deck,) the Kick-Off Barbeque and our Awards Banquet (player only, parents and guests buy additional tickets.)

Included in this packet is an "Athlete Sponsorship" letter that your athlete can make copies of and fill in his name. These can be used to solicit help from others in meeting each athlete's Booster fees.

Transportation form: The cost will be determined by PYLUSD Transportation. It has been around \$65. This form must be completed and paid at the barbeque.

Medical emergency cards: Must be completed and turned in at the barbeque. Be sure to bring any pertinent info with you to help fill out the form.

Sponsorships: Program sponsorships help us a great deal in offsetting expenses and are welcome throughout the year. If you know of anyone or a business that can help us, we have a form with the requisite Tax ID# for their use. This is in the packet.

Snack Shack: As a service to our athletes and our spectators, we run a snack shack. Please volunteer an hour or two to help us in this endeavor. We will discuss this at the barbeque.

Belmont Plaza - Ocean Blvd., Long Beach (310) 438-1142 Take 55 Fwy South to the 22 Fwy West. Exit Studebaker. Go South (left). Turn West (right) on Westminster (turns into Second Street). South (left) on Bayshore. Turn West (right) on Ocean Blvd. Turn left into the parking lot. (pay to park)

Brea Olinda High School - 789 Wildcat Way, Brea 57 Fwy North to Lambert Rd., go East (right) to WildCat Way and turn North (left). School is on the left side of the street

Canyon High School - 220 S. Imperial Hwy, Anaheim 91 Fwy to Imperial Hwy, exit and go South (right) on Imperial Hwy across Santa Ana Canyon Rd. School is on the left side of the road.

Capistrano Valley High School (Capo Valley) - 26301 Via Escolar, Capistrano Valley 5 Fwy to Avery, exit and go East (left under fwy) to Marguerite Parkway, South (right) to Via Escolar, East (left) to school which is on the left side.

Chino High School - 91 Fwy East to 71 Fwy North. Exit at Central Ave. Go North to Riverside Dr. Turn East (right) on Riverside Dr. to 10th St. School is on the right. (or 57 Fwy North to 60 Fwy East, exit at Central Ave. Turn South (right) to Walnut Ave turn East (left) to 10th St.

Corona Del Mar High School - 2101 Eastbluff Dr. Newport Beach Take the 55 Fwy South or the 405 Fwy South to 73 Fwy, South to Jamboree Rd. Exit, and go right on East Bluff Dr. School is on the west side of street.

Dana Hills High School - 33333 Golden Lantern, Dana Point Take 5 fwy. South, Exit Crown Valley Pkwy going West (right). Turn South (left) on Golden Lantern. School on right before Stonehill Dr.

Heritage Park Aquatics Center - 4601 Walnut Ave., Irvine (714) 559-0472 Take 55 Fwy. South to 5 Fwy. South, exit Culver going South (right). Turn East (left) on Walnut. {Irvine H.S. is adjacent to Heritage Park}

Janet Evans Swim Complex (formerly Independence Park) - 801 W. Valencia Dr., Fullerton (714) 738-5369 Take the 91 Fwy. West, exit Euclid Ave. going North (right), turn East (right) on Valencia. Pool is in the left just past DMV.

Katella High School - 2200 Wagner St., Anaheim Take 91 Fwy. West, 57 Fwy. South, exit Ball Rd. going West (right). Go North (right) on Sunkist and West (left) on Wagner.

Laguna Beach High School - 625 Park Ave., Laguna Beach. Take the CA-91 East/Riverside FWY. Take CA-241 South Ramp towards Irvine. Merge onto CA-241 S (Portions toll). Take CA-133 South Ramp towards (I-5). Merge onto CA-133 S (portions toll). Turn slight left onto Laguna Canyon RD/CA-133. Turn slight left onto Forest Ave. Stay straight to go onto 3RD ST. Turn left onto Park Ave.

Los Alamitos High School - 3591 Cerritos Ave., Los Alamitos Take 91 Fwy West then Southbound on 605 Fwy to Cerritos Ave., Go East (left under fwy) past Los Alamitos Blvd., Pool off of Cerritos. (or 55 Fwy South to 22 Fwy West that turns into 405 Fwy North, exit Los Alamitos Blvd. going North (right). Turn East (right) on Cerritos Blvd.

Los Alamitos Joint Forces Training Center - (562)-795-2000 Take 91 Fwy (West), Exit Valley View (turn left), Katella Ave. (turn right), go about 11/2 Miles (will pass Los Alamitos Race Track), Lexington Dr. (turn left), Pass gate going into Base, Sarratoga (turn left - where helicopter located on the ground), Valley Forge (turn left), Parking lot is on the left and pool is on the right).

Marina High School - 15871 Springdale St., Huntington Beach [55 Fwy South to 22 Fwy West. Exit Valley View going South (left under fwy) Street changes to Bolsa Chica. Turn East (left) on Edinger and North (left) on Springdale. (or 55 fwy South to 405 fwy North, Exit Beach Blvd going South (left under fwy). Turn West (right) on Edinger then North (right) on Springdale Newport Harbor High School - 600 Irvine Ave., Newport Beach Take 55 fwy. South to the end where it changes into Newport Blvd. Turn East (left) on 17th Street and South (right) on Irvine Ave., East (left) on 15th St.

Riverside Poly - (Sippy Woodhead Pool at Bobby Bonds Park) Riverside Take 91 Fwy East, exit University Ave. going East (right). Park is just past Kansas Ave. on the right.

Saddleback College - 28000 Marguerite Pkwy, Mission Viejo 5 Fwy to Avery , exit and go East (left under fwy) to Marguerite Parkway, turn North (left). Campus on the right.

San Clemente High School - 700 Ave. Pico, San Clemente Take 55 fwy. South to 5 fwy South. Exit Ave. Pico. Turn East (left under fwy). Campus on the right.

Servite High School - 1952 W. La Palma Ave., Anaheim Take 91 fwy. West, Exit Euclid going South (left under fwy.) Turn West (right) on La Palma. School on the left.

Tustin High School - 1171 El Camino Real, Tustin Take 55 fwy. South to 5 fwy. South. Exit Newport Ave. going North (left under fwy.) Turn East (right) on El Camino Real. Campus on left.

Valencia High School - 500 N. Bradford, Placentia Take Orangethorpe to Chapman Ave. Turn right. Turn North (right) on Bradford. School is on the right.

Villa Park High School - 18042 Taft Ave., Villa Park Take Imperial Hwy. South over the hill (turns into Canon). Turn West (right) on Taft. School on left, after Center Dr. {or take 91 fwy West, 55 fwy. South, Exit Katella going East (left under fwy). Turn North (left) on Santiago, East (right) on Taft. School on the right.}

Edison High School - 21400 Magnolia Street, Huntington Beach Take 405 Fwy to Magnolia St., south to Hamilton Ave., east to school which is at the corner of Magnolia St and Hamilton Ave.

El Dorado High School - 1651 N. Valencia Ave., Placentia Take Yorba Linda Blvd. West to Valencia Ave. North (right). School on the left.

El Toro High School - 25255 Toledo Way, El Toro Take 5 fwy. South, Exit Lake Forest Dr. going East (left under fwy) to Toledo Way. Turn South (right). School on left.

Estancia High School - 2323 Placentia Ave., Costa Mesa[Go south on 55 Fwy. Exit at Victoria St. Turn West (right) on Victoria to Placentia Ave. Turn North (right) on Placentia. School on your left once you pass Wilson St.

Foothill High School - 19251 Dodge Ave., Tustin Take the 55 Fwy. South, exit Seventeenth St., turn East (left) under fwy., Turn North (left) on Newport Ave., then West (left) on Dodge Ave.

Fountain Valley High School - 17816 Bushard St., Fountain Valley 405 Fwy to Brookhurst, Go South (left-under fwy) to Talbert, turn West (right) on Talbert, turn North (right) on Bushard St.

Fullerton High School - 201 E. Chapman Ave., Fullerton Take 91 Fwy West, exit Lemon. Turn North (right), School just North of Chapman Ave.

Golden West College - 15744 Goldenwest, Huntington Beach From North or South 405 exit on Goldenwest. Travel South just past McFadden (towards Huntington Beach). Parking lots off Goldenwest or McFadden ***\$1.00 parking fee at machines.*** Pool behind tennis courts.

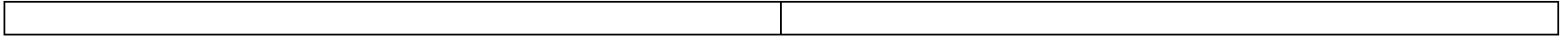
Harvard Westlake High School - 3700 Coldwater Canyon, N. Hollywood Take 5 Fwy. North to 101 Fwy. North, exit Coldwater Canyon and go South (left-under fwy). School is on the left just past Ventura Blvd.

Sonora High School - 401 S. Palm Street, La Habra East on Imperial Highway, right on Palm Street, school is on the left after you cross Lambert

Huntington Beach High School - 1905 Main Street, Huntington Beach (714) 536-2514 Take 55 Fwy South to 405 Fwy North, exit Brookhurst Street south (right), go west (right) on Ellis Ave, Ellis veers left and becomes Main Street. School is on the right.

Newport Harbor High School - 600 Irvine Avenue, Newport Beach (949) 515-6300 Take 55 Fwy South, Fwy ends and becomes Newport Blvd, go east (left) on E17th Street, turn right on Irvine Blvd. School is on the left, pool parking off 15th street.

Mira Costa High School - 701 S. Peck Avenue, Manhattan Beach (310) 318-7337 Take 91 Fwy West until it ends and the freeway becomes Artesia Boulevard. Continue on Artesia Blvd for approx. 6 miles. The school is on the right at the corner of Artesia Blvd. & Peck Ave. Use S. Meadows Avenue (1st street after Peck on right) for street parking nearest the pool.
